Unconditional grants, academic achievement, and residency permits for all! Many students need to prove their academic achievement to obtain financial support. The measures taken by the universities in response to the COVID-19 Virus, such as stopping courses indefinitely, must, at a minimum, be joined by a refund of tuition fees and toleration of an extra semester to achieve requirements. An unconditional guarantee must be given for financial aid claims, residency permits, and grants.
